THE ERASMUS+ PROGRAM

Erasmus+ is the EU's program to support education, training, youth and sport in Europe.

Students enrolled in the 5th -6th year who have completed all the exams of the 4th year are given the opportunity to carry out part of the "tirocinio pratico-valutativo abilitante ai fini dell'Esame di Stato" (TA) at the host institution (except for the internship at the General Practitioner, which must be carried out in Italy). - b) Interview score ranges from 0 to 10 points. The interview can be organized online, if requested.
- 3. Additional scores are assigned to students with fewer opportunities (max 5 points) in order to support greater inclusion and participation in mobility projects.
- 4. Additional scores (max. 5 points) will be awarded for training activities that include the development of advanced digital skills, such as big data analysis, use of artificial intelligence, learning programming languages, etc. as they fall within the priorities of the Erasmus+ programme.
- 5. In case of equal score, priority will be given to the student who has not already attended a mobility abreading data





- a) Traineeship Certificate issued by the host institution, stating the assessment of the work carried out, in accordance with what was agreed in the Learning Agreement
- b) Narrative Report (EU Participant Survey). The invitation to fill in the EU Participant Survey is sent by e-mail by the European Commission.
- c) Final report and brief description of the experience to be uploaded on the Lausanne site for SEMP grants.

The deadlines and procedures for completing, handing in and/or signing the aforementioned documents will be communicated to the students during the preparation for the mobility. Failure to deliver the documents to the Erasmus office by the deadline of 15 July 2026, and/or failure to complete the EU Survey by the required deadline, will result in the reimbursement of the Erasmus+ grant.

9. Personal data protection
