

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF NON-EU SCHOLARSHIPS FOR THE 2024-2025 ACADEMIC YEAR

REGULATION FOR THE AWARD OF TWO (2) SCHOLARSHIPS FUNDED BY HUMANITAS UNIVERSITY. SCHOLARSHIPS ARE RESERVED FOR NON-EUROPEAN CITIZENS WHO APPLY FOR THE FIRST YEAR OF THE SINGLE CYCLE DEGREE COURSE IN MEDICINE AND SURGERY IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE CALLED MEDTEC SCHOOL FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-2025 (Class LM-41)

FOREWORD

Based on the belief that deserving and motivated students should be supported in pursuing their academic and professional aspirations, Humanitas University has decided to fund two (2) scholarships reserved for Non-EU citizens who wish to enroll in the first year of the Single Cycle Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery in English called MEDTEC School in the academic year 2024-2025 (class LM-41).

Art. 1. Categories and Value of Scholarships

The two (2) available scholarships are:

• Two (2) partial scholarships.

The value of the two (2) scholarships is determined by:

• Two (2) partial scholarships valued at 18,000.00 each

Scholarships will be awarded for each academic year until graduation, according to the criteria established in Art. 4 of this Regulation.

As established in Art. 5, Humanitas University will undertake fiscal burdens in terms of taxation for each scholarship - provided for by the regulations in force.

The academic costs for Non-EU students enrolled in the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery called MEDTEC School of Humanitas University are found in **Table 1**.
